Holistic Scoring

Score 4

- The student completes all of the components of the tasks and expresses the idea of the task effectively
- The student demonstrates a depth of understanding about the main concepts or ideas expressed in the project
- The student's project shows a sophistication of completeness and attention to detail and presents a polished finish
- The student's projects reflects or offers an interpretation, extension, or application of the subject (if appropriate)

Score 3

- The student completes most of the components of the task and communicates those ideas clearly
- The student demonstrates understanding of the main concepts but may have overlooked or misunderstood details
- The student has done a fairly complete job but the feeling remains that more could have been done to express more details

Score 2

- The student completes some of the components of the task and communicates those ideas clearly
- The student demonstrates that there are gaps in his/her understanding of the main concepts
- The student has done only a passable job and the feeling remains that an attempt was made but minimal effort was given

Score 1

- The student completes little of the components and does not communicate those ideas clearly
- The student shows minimal understanding of the concepts and details
- The student has not demonstrated much effort
